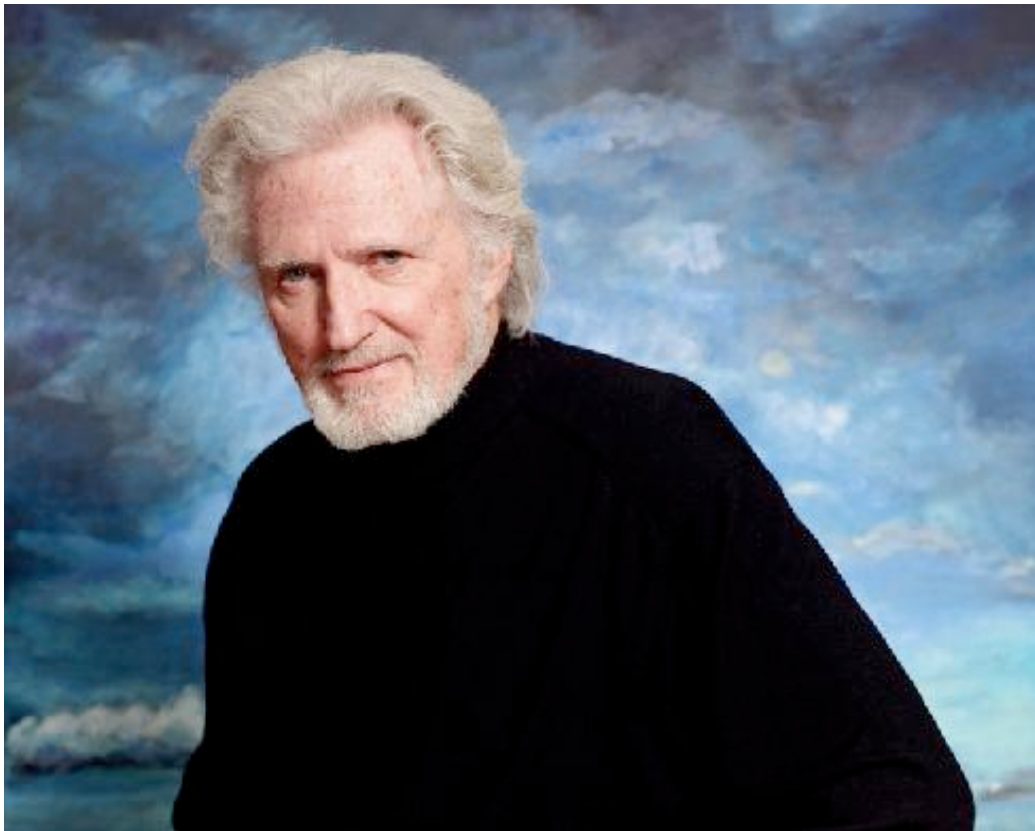

Robert Brown is equally comfortable in front of or behind the camera. "He has a keen eye for people and places that speak about their uniqueness," comments Margaret Travers, executive director, Ventura County Arts Council. In 1958 his friend, the legendary photographer Diane Arbus, urged him to always have his camera ready, "to look for truths that might be hidden anywhere and everywhere." The son of English and Scottish parents, he grew up in The Bronx, fought in World War II and on his return in 1946 studied acting at The Dramatic Workshop in Manhattan. In 1948 Robert was directed by Lee Strasberg in his first Broadway play. Working with the "greats of the theatre" was a constant inspiration. Varied New York stage roles took him from Shakespeare to James Joyce's Ulysses In Nighttown to Hollywood's Star Trek. He starred in the popular ABC television series Here Come The Brides as Jason Bolt. Reserve your seat now!
